FILE YOUR TAX RETURN ON TIME

The 2008/09 tax returns for individuals were issued on 4 May 2009. Taxpayers are required to file duly completed returns to the Inland Revenue Department (IRD) within 1 month. The deadline falls on 4 June 2009. For sole proprietors, returns can be filed within 3 months on or before 4 August 2009. An automatic extension of 1 month is allowed to all e-filers, that is, eTAX users filing their individual tax returns on-line could have the deadline extended to 4 July 2009. For e-filers of sole proprietorship businesses, the deadline is extended to 4 September 2009.

If you have not received a tax return due to change of postal address, you may:

- file the tax return online or obtain a duplicate tax return and notify change of address instantly on the Internet through <www.gov.hk> if you are a holder of digital certificate or an eTAX Password;
- complete the form below and send it to the IRD by fax at 2877 1232 or by post to GPO Box 132, Hong Kong; or
- call in person at the Enquiry Counter, 1/F, Revenue Tower, 5 Gloucester Road, Wan Chai.

If you only request a duplicate tax return, you can also contact the IRD staff at 187 8022 during office hours.
