

## Assistant Taxation Officer

**Entry Requirements:** Candidates (1)(a) should have Level 2 or equivalent <sup>Note (i)</sup> or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination (HKDSEE), or equivalent; or (1)(b) should have Level 2 <sup>Note (ii)</sup> / Grade E or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in the Hong Kong Certificate of Education Examination (HKCEE), or equivalent; and (2) should have met the language proficiency requirements of Level 2 <sup>Note (ii)</sup> or above in Chinese Language and English Language in the HKDSEE or HKCEE, or equivalent; and (3) should be able to speak fluent Cantonese and English; and (4) possessing relevant knowledge in accounting and / or taxation would be an advantage.

*Note (i) For civil service appointment purpose, "Attained with Distinction" in Applied Learning subjects (subject to a maximum of two Applied Learning subjects), and Grade C in Other Language subjects in the HKDSEE are accepted as equivalent to Level 3 in the New Senior Secondary subjects in the HKDSEE. "Attained" in Applied Learning subjects (subject to a maximum of two Applied Learning subjects), and Grade E in Other Language subjects in the HKDSEE are accepted as equivalent to Level 2 in the New Senior Secondary subjects in the HKDSEE.*

*Note (ii) For civil service appointment purpose, Grade C and Grade E in Chinese Language and English Language (Syllabus B) in the HKCEE before 2007 are accepted administratively as comparable to Level 3 and Level 2 respectively in Chinese Language and English Language in the 2007 HKCEE and henceforth.*

*Note (ii) Candidates fulfilling the above entry requirements should state in details their relevant qualifications and experience obtained in their application forms. The level of language proficiency in Chinese Language and English Language they attained should also be stated clearly.*

*Note (iv) For the purpose of heightening public awareness of the Basic Law (BL) and promoting a culture of learning of BL in the community, assessment of BL knowledge will be included in the recruitment for all civil service jobs. Candidates who are invited to attend the recruitment interview will be assessed on their BL knowledge through a written test to be conducted immediately before or after the recruitment interview. The BL test result will be one of the considerations to assess the suitability of a candidate but will not affect his / her eligibility for applying for civil service jobs.*
