Entry Requirements: Candidates should (1)(a) have Level 2 or equivalent Note (i) or above in five subjects including Chinese Language and English Language in the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination (HKDSEE), or equivalent; or (1)(b) have Level 2 Note (ii) / Grade E or above in five subjects including Chinese Language and English Language in the Hong Kong Certificate of Education Examination (HKCEE), or equivalent; (2) have three years' working experience in accounting or audit and have a good knowledge of Chinese commercial accounting methods (single-entry) and double-entry book-keeping Note (iii); (3) have met the language proficiency requirements of Level 2 Note (ii) or above in Chinese Language and English Language in the HKDSEE or HKCEE Note (iii), or equivalent; (4) be mature; and (5) be able to speak fluent Cantonese and English.

- Note (i) For civil service appointment purpose, "Attained" in Applied Learning subjects (subject to a maximum of two Applied Learning subjects), and Grade E in Other Language subjects in the HKDSEE are accepted as equivalent to Level 2 in the New Senior Secondary subjects in the HKDSEE.
- Note (ii) For civil service appointment purpose, Grade C and Grade E in Chinese Language and English Language (Syllabus B) in the HKCEE before 2007 are accepted administratively as comparable to Level 3 and Level 2 respectively in Chinese Language and English Language in the 2007 HKCEE and henceforth.
- Note (iii) Candidates fulfilling the above entry requirements should state in detail their working experience in accounting or audit, and knowledge of Chinese commercial accounting and book-keeping in the application forms. The level of language proficiency in Chinese Language and English Language they attainted should also be stated clearly.
- Note (iv) For the purpose of heightening public awareness of the Basic Law (BL) and promoting a culture of learning of BL in the community, applicants for civil service jobs will be assessed on their BL knowledge. The BL test result will constitute an appropriate weighting in a candidate's overall assessment. Candidates who are invited to attend the recruitment interview will be assessed on their BL knowledge through a written test to be conducted immediately after the recruitment interview.
